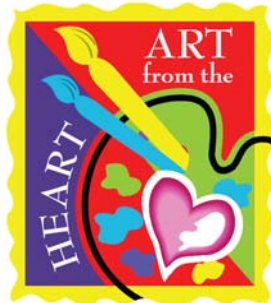
- sports polo due 28/02

## Art from the Heart



Cedars are now offering an after school tutoring program called 'Art from the Heart.' Students will explore many different visual art techniques including drawing, painting, pastel, collage and ceramic sculpture.

Classes will be held weekly on Tuesday or Wednesday afternoons from 3.30 to 5.30pm. First lesson is Tuesday the 9th of Feb or Wed the 10th. This program is suitable for students from Years 4 - 12.

Cost is \$30 per lesson over a 7 week period. 1 day per week = \$210 per Term, 2 days per week = \$420 per Term. Payments need to be finalised by week 3 of program. Classes run from Tuesday 9th of Feb until Wednesday 31st March.

## Parking

As you may be aware the development of our new hall is underway. This means that buildings have been relocated to the area of land, west of Senior College that previously was available for parking. You will appreciate that this may cause some traffic congestion at drop off and pick up times.

### Things to consider:

- Our neighbours: Please do not park in front of driveways or on lawns.
- Pedestrians: There is a lot of foot traffic at these times from the public and from members of our School community. Safety must be our top priority.
- Road Rules: Please follow road rules including speed limits, no u-turns, and not parking in 'no standing zones'. Police do patrol the area and will hand out fines.
- Drop off and Pick up zones: Please use these areas appropriately. Do not park and wait for your children. Do not leave your car.
- Bus Zones: No cars are to stop in the Bus Zones. Please keep an eye out for children in these areas.
- Pedestrian Crossing: There is a pedestrian crossing available between the Junior School and the Nursing Home. Please use this crossing as it is there for your safety and we need to model the correct procedures for our children.

### What should you do?:

- Arrive early if possible, park and walk to the gates to meet your children.
- Arrive after the rush to avoid the congestion.
- Use the pick up zones; drive on if your child is not ready.
- Use patience.
