## CYBER BULLYING SURVEY

**TUESDAY JUNE 21, 2011**

Our Year 7 and 9 students have the opportunity to take part in a research project through Macquarie University entitled "The Influence of Cyber Bullying on Adolescent Development." Student participation will involve sitting a 50 minute online survey on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2011 and responses will be completely confidential.

Each child who participates will be asked to answer questions about their experiences of cyber bullying, their self-efficacy to respond to cyber-bullying, and the psychological effects that cyber-bullying has on them. Mrs Reynolds has been given a copy of the questionnaire for her approval prior to the commencement of the research.

Cedars Christian College is keenly interested in research on the impact of the use of technology in bullying and a summary of the results will be forwarded to the school.
